

MTTI Student Policies re: COVID-19

Update: 2/22/2022

To ensure the health and safety of all students and staff at MTTI, all students and staff must follow the following procedures & precautions:

- 1) Masks are no longer required for unvaccinated individuals, but students or staff may opt to wear a mask if they chose to do so.
 - a. Any individuals who harass or bully other students for opting to wear a mask will be subject to disciplinary action – this type of behavior will not be tolerated.
 - b. Masks must be worn by individuals who are observing COVID-19 precautions following a positive COVID test or exposure. That timeline will be determined by the Department of Health.
- 2) Upon entry to the school, students will be asked to sign a modified COVID-19 Daily Screening log.
- 3) Any staff or students who that are sick or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent home immediately and asked to follow-up with their doctor or take a COVID-19 test.
 - a. A doctor's note or negative COVID-19 test will be required for return.
- 4) Any staff or students who have been exposed to COVID-19 should contact the Department of Health right away and follow their direction on getting tested. They should notify MTTI immediately upon notification of exposure.
 - a. Any individuals who are not vaccinated must leave school right away to get tested. Those who are vaccinated must wear a mask for 10 days following exposure and schedule a test within that time period.
- 5) Students should make every effort to get tested right away when required to do so. If you are having trouble finding a test within 24 hours, call MTTI for assistance.
- 6) At designated times, all students must wipe down the area (equipment, surfaces, tools, etc.) that they were working in with disinfectant supplied by the school.
- 7) Students must immediately notify MTTI if they have tested positive for COVID-19 or have recently been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Anyone not abiding by these policies and procedures or providing false vaccination documentation will be subject to disciplinary action, which may include termination from the program. These policies and procedures are for your own health and safety and should not be taken lightly.
